

NEW YORK CITY POPULATION DENSITY (2010)

A map showing 2010 population by Neighborhood Tabulation Areas (NTAs) in New York City.

NTAs are medium-sized statistical geographies for reporting Decennial Census and American Community Survey (ACS). NTA boundaries and their associated names roughly correspond with many neighborhoods commonly recognized by New Yorkers.

In the year 2010, a total of 10 NTAs had a population density exceeding 100,000 individuals per square mile, with all of them situated exclusively within the boroughs of Manhattan and the Bronx.
